DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

Under the leadership of the Manager, Occupational Health & Safety (OHS), and working together with the Occupational Health & Safety Specialists, the role of the Senior Occupational Health & Safety Specialist supports, develops and implements Occupational Health and Safety Programs for Lakeridge Health. Examples of these programs include Respiratory Protection, Personal Protective Equipment, Hazardous Materials Risk Management, Occupational Hygiene (air quality, mould, heat/cold stress, vibration, radiation and noise), WHMIS, Confined Spaces, Contractor Safety, Lockout/Tagout, Powered Material Handling, Anaesthetic Gases, Antineoplastic Agents, Slips/Trips/Falls Prevention, Sharps Injury Prevention and Ergonomics. Responsible for coordinating, developing, and implementing departmental goals and projects. This role also contributes to OHS Safety policy and procedure development and review, OHS promotion, recognition and new employee orientation, JHSC compliance monitoring and support, OHS Training/Education, and Staff Incident review/analysis. This role will provide back-up support to the Manager, OHS, as needed.
